

How to Access Telemedicine

When you enroll in any State Health plan (Anthem/Blue Cross Blue Shield, United Healthcare, or Kaiser), you have a *telemedicine option*. That means you can get a diagnosis & prescription from home, work, or on-the-go without going to a doctor's office. Instead, you can see and talk to a doctor from your mobile device, tablet, or computer with a webcam. The service is a quick, inexpensive way to get care for common illnesses like cold, flu, sinus infections, rashes, pink eye, etc.

Note : This option is not for treatment of serious or chronic conditions and controlled substances are not prescribed via these visits.

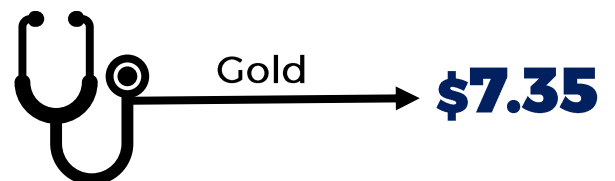
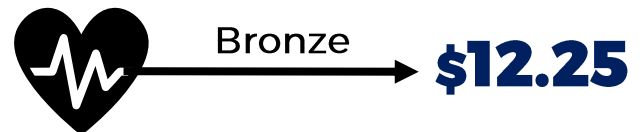
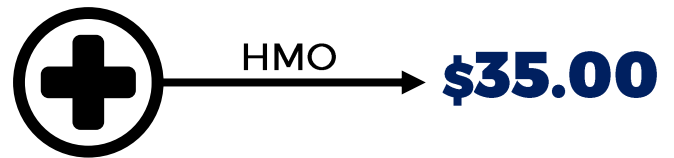
For United Healthcare
